Terms of Reference for Office Equipment Tagging Services

Job Summary: The AIHD seeks an experienced service provider to provide office equipment tagging services. This will provide systematic identification and registration of office equipment to safeguard and improve the management of the office's assets.

Scope of Work

- Tag all office equipment, including but not limited to printers, laptops and furniture.
- Supply durable tags to suit the nature of the equipment and the storage environment.
- Create a database of tagged items, complete with the type, location and unique identification numbers.
- Advise on asset tagging and maintenance of the assets register.
- Hand over all relevant documentation for AIHD's use.

Timeline

This assignment must be completed before **December 19th, 2025**, before the office's Christmas break.

Requirements and Qualifications

Interested service providers must demonstrate:

- Proven experience in tagging office equipment and inventory management.
- Ability to provide the service within the stipulated timelines.
- Ability to deliver high-quality tagging materials for the different equipment.
- Excellent communication skills.
